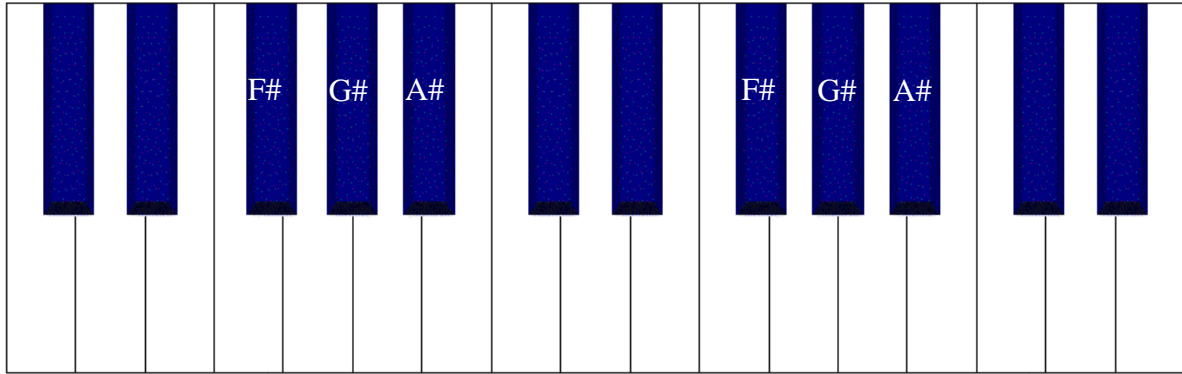
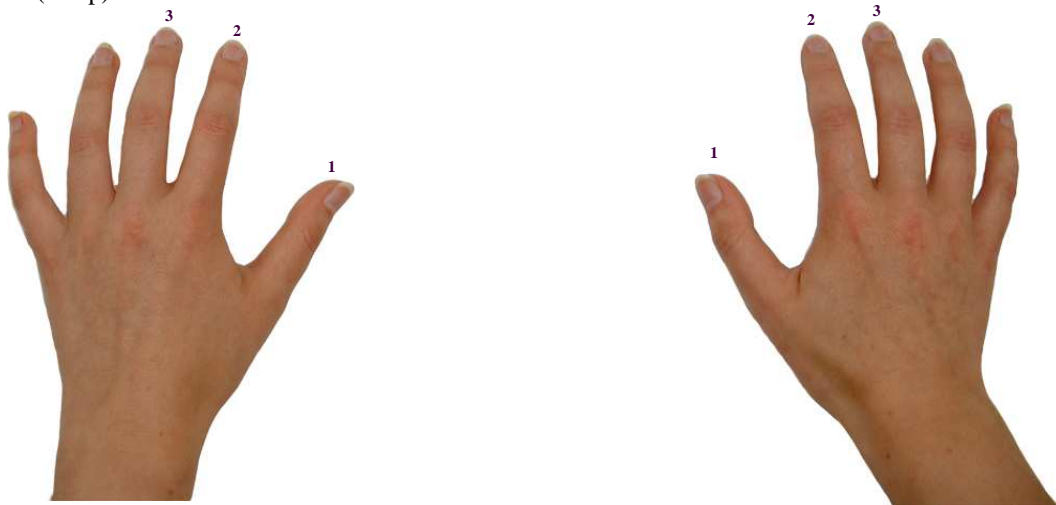



Starting with the black keys

Half notes and quarter notes

In the first pieces, we come across half note () and quarter note () values.
We will count Quarter notes as one beat and half notes as two beats.
Thus a four-beat measure is called "4/4 measure".
